TEENAGE PROGRAM

The purpose of this program is to recognize and deal with the issues of adolescents in care as well as peer pressure, education and careers, puberty and sexuality, self esteem, drugs and alcohol, choices and decisions including skills to get ready for semi independence.



MODEL OF THE FOSTER AGENCY

Johnson Children's Services is a mixed modality setting located across the Eastern Central and Western regions of Ontario. We provide residential services for latency and adolescent aged children and their families. Homes operate as mixed modality setting, with clinical services, life skills development, and recreational programming, to support a successful treatment plan. We provide a safe, supportive and nurturing environment. Within the normalized setting, there is a focus placed on skill development and growth.
